Subaward Process Update

In order the streamline the OSP / departmental correspondence for Subawards, a realignment of workflow was made so that your department's Grant/Contract Administrator will process all subawards for the department.

In addition, modifications to subawards will be processed through Workday:

- Effective Date: December 22, 2015
 - The <u>Subaward Order Form</u> is completed and uploaded in Workday as an attachment to the Change Purchase Order request
 - This is routed to Pre-Award for processing for review
 - Approved once the final documents are signed
 - Signed Modification will be uploaded in Workday to the Purchase Order record
 - Other process approvals remain unchanged.

Workshop on the New NSF Public Access Policy

As the new NSF Public Access Policy emerges in January (https://www.nsf.gov/news/special reports/public access/), that among other items, will require NSF-funded investigators to submit publications resulting from NSF-funded research to a publications-repository, NSF-PAR (http://par.nsf.gov/), the Brown Library will be hosting a meeting for researchers and staff at Brown to meet to discuss what people may know and what we do not yet know about this new public access policy, steps institutions are taking for compliance, and how this will affect the sharing of the results of research, both publications and data, in the coming year.
