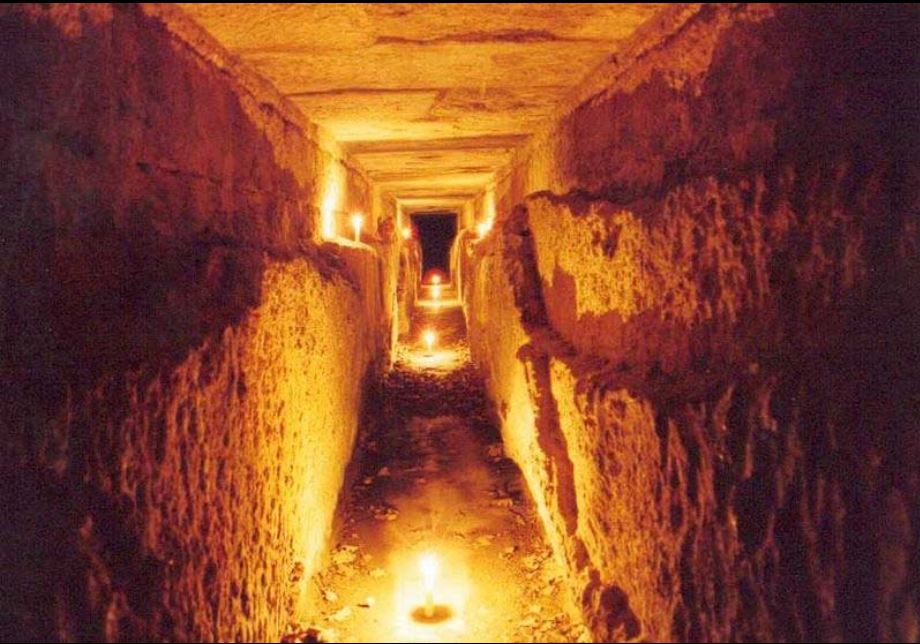

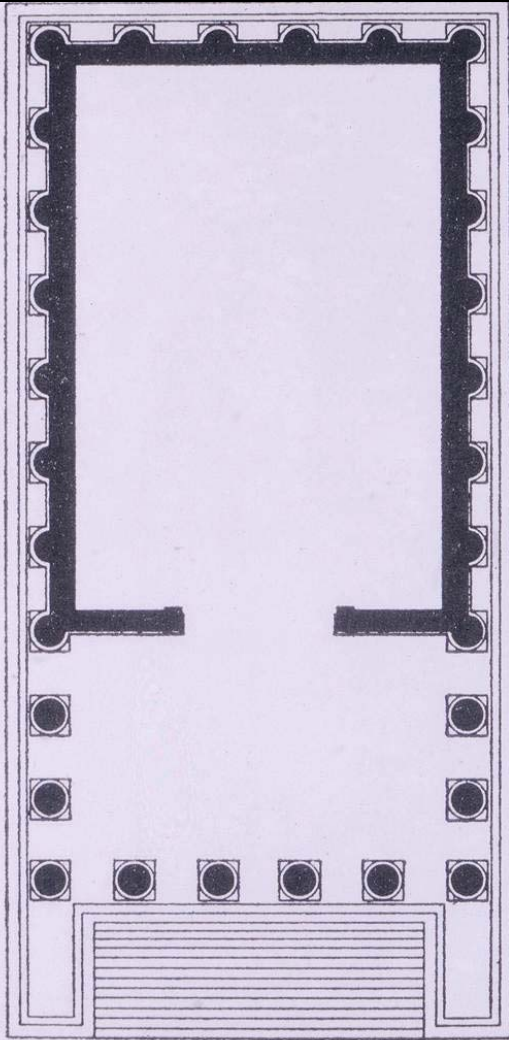




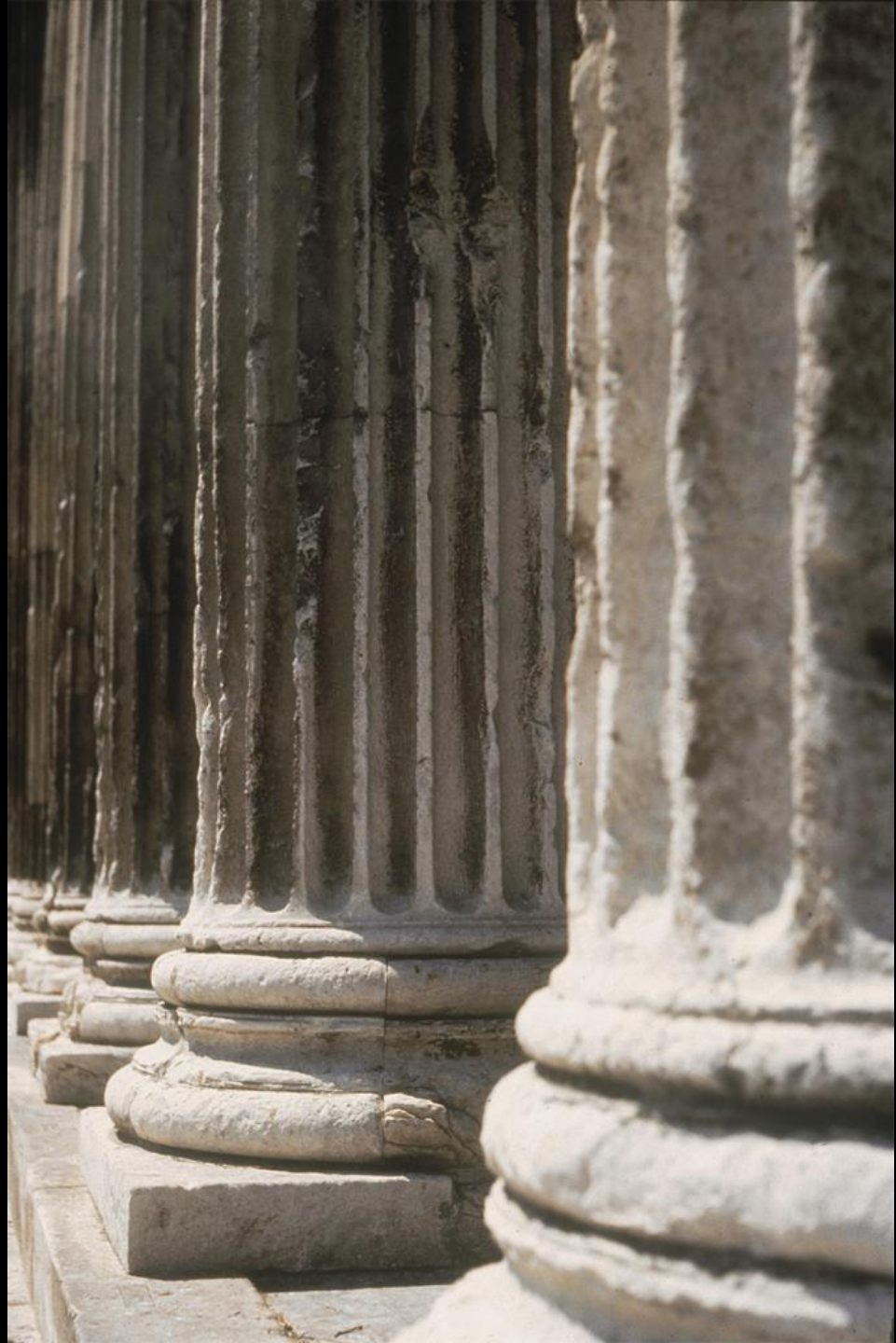












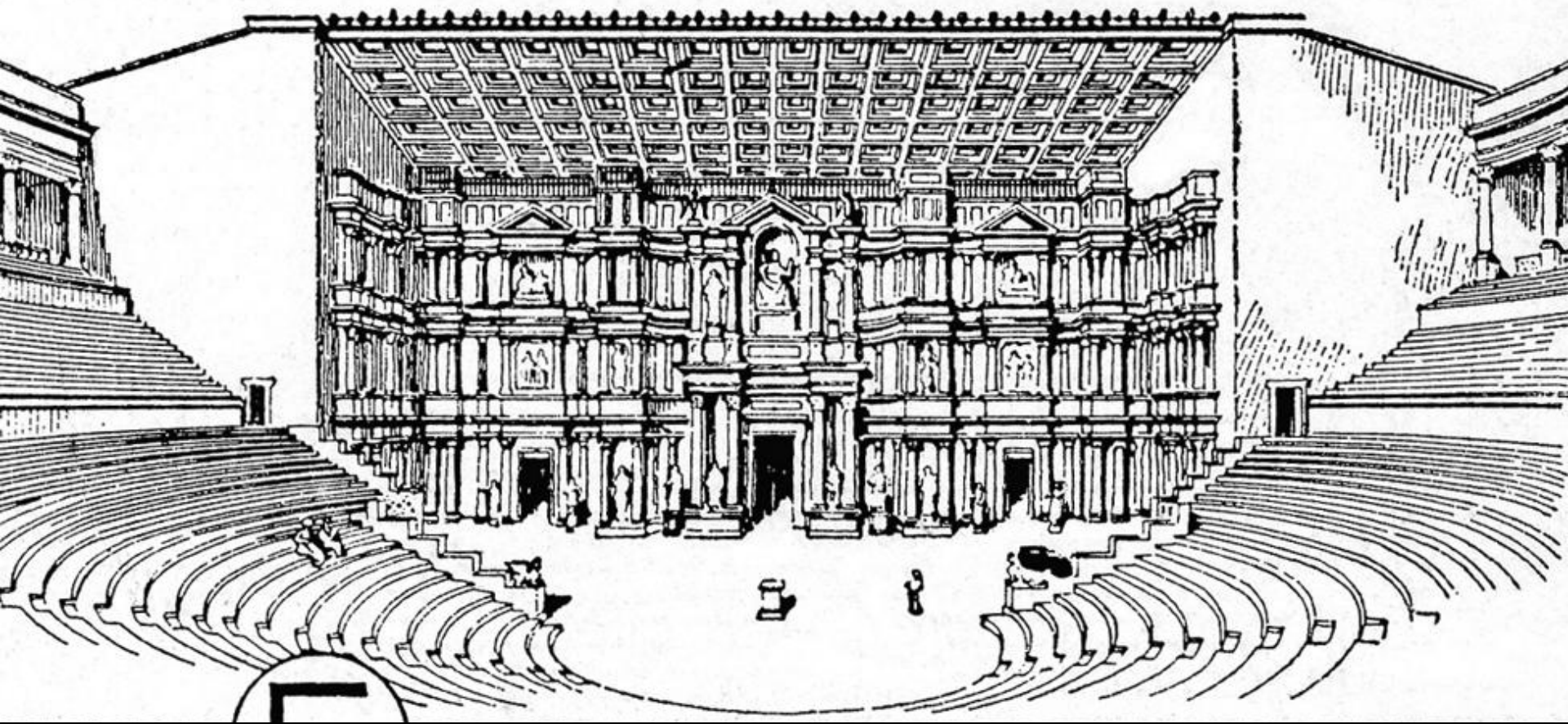




THEATER, ORANGE (ARAUSIO), 1stc. AD

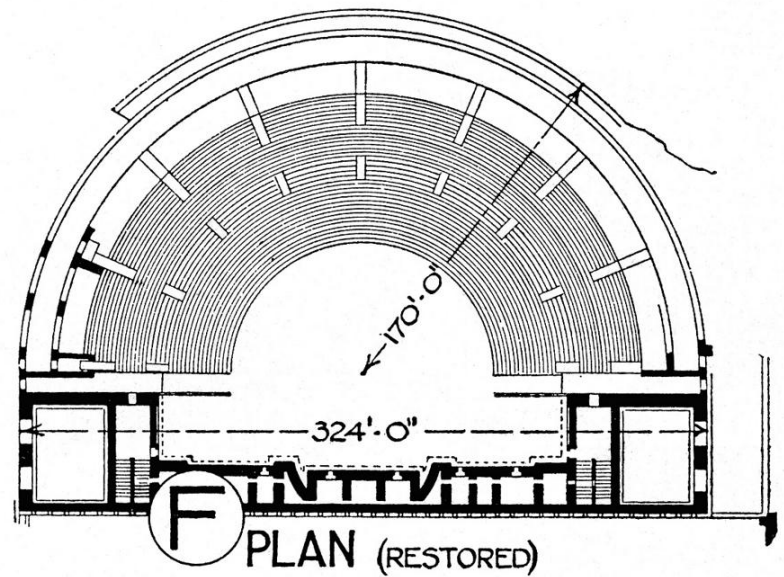
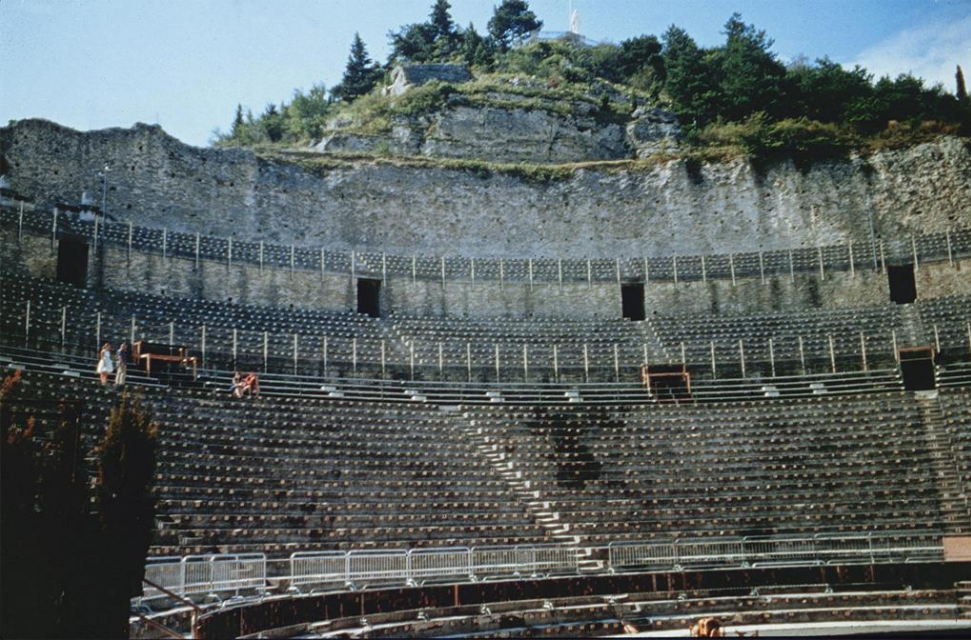








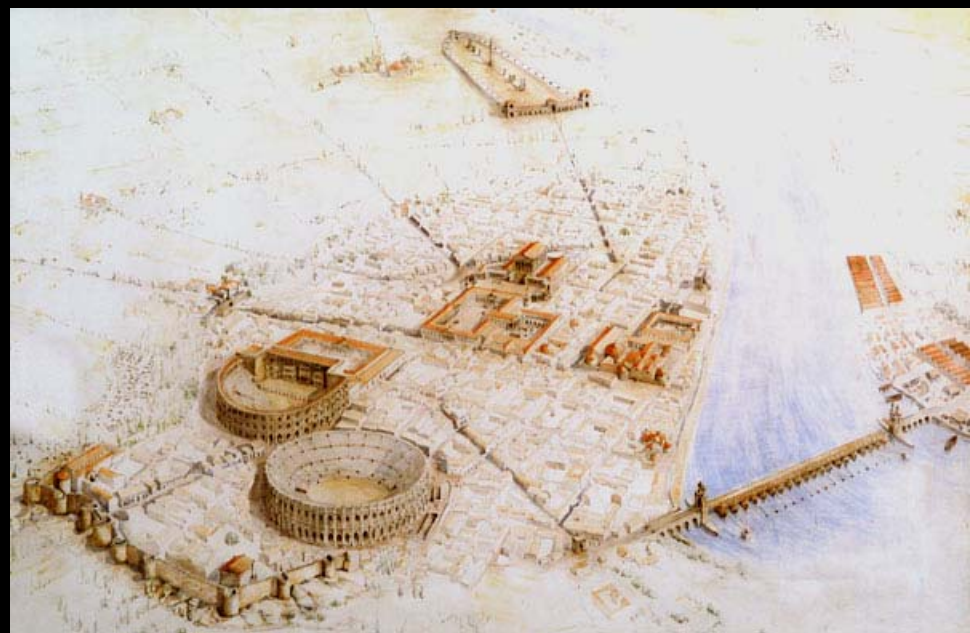






ARLES (ARELATE)

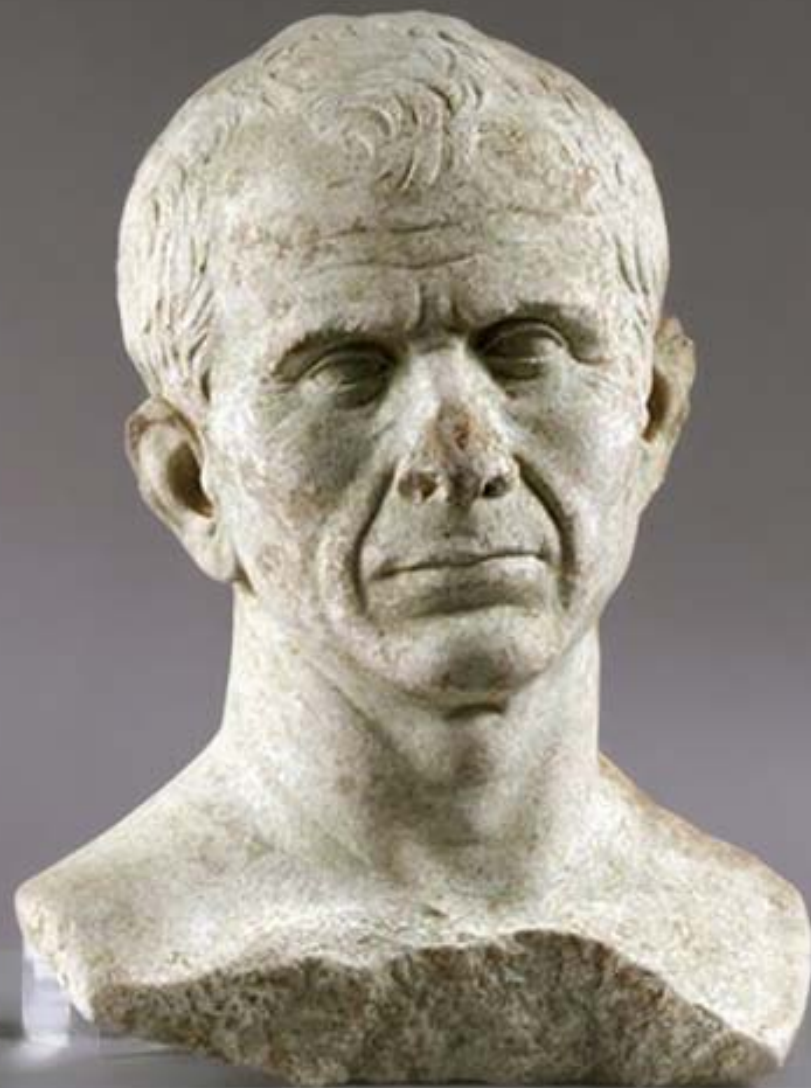




ARLES AMPHITHEATER (2nd half 1stc. AD)











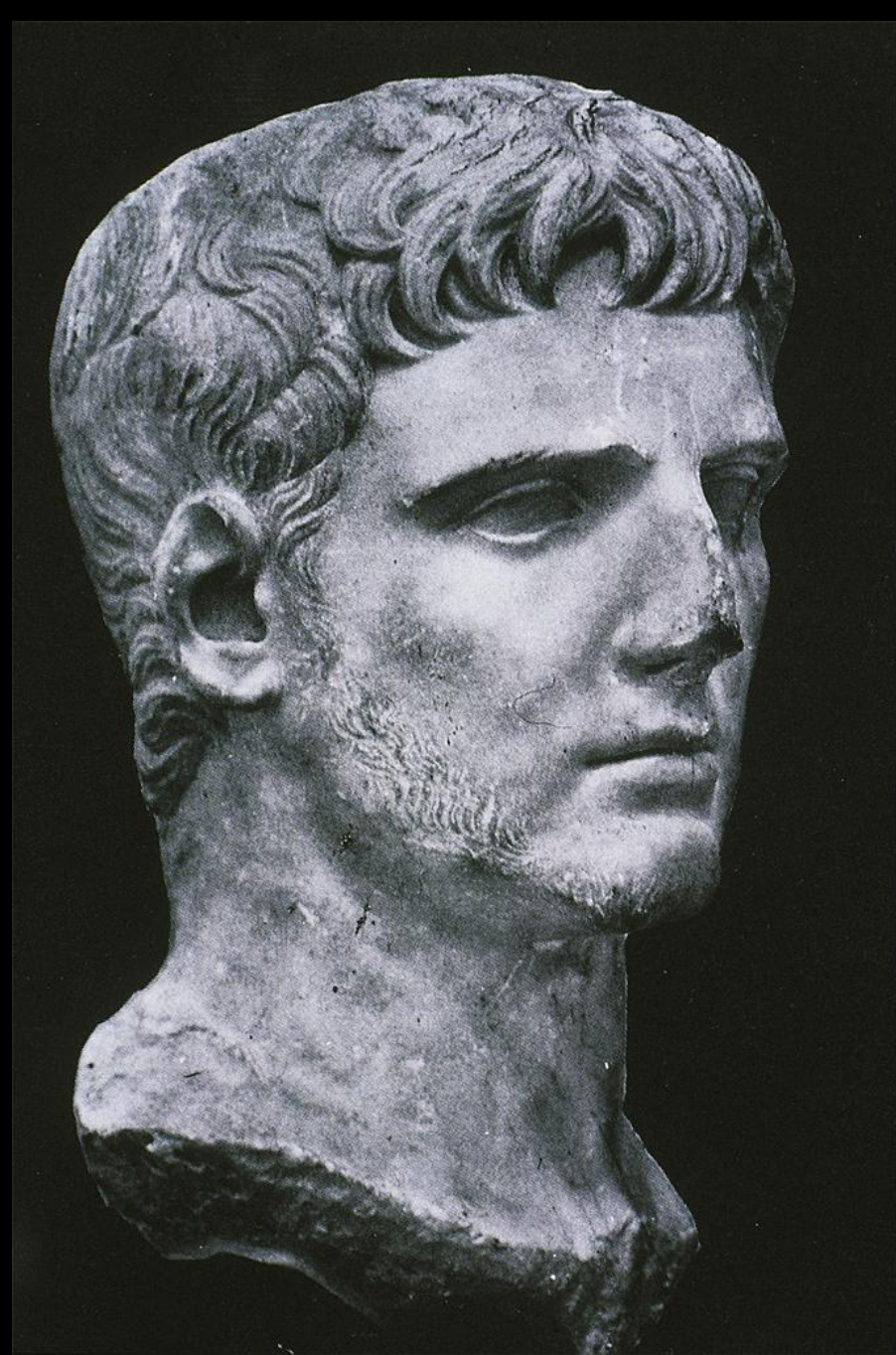
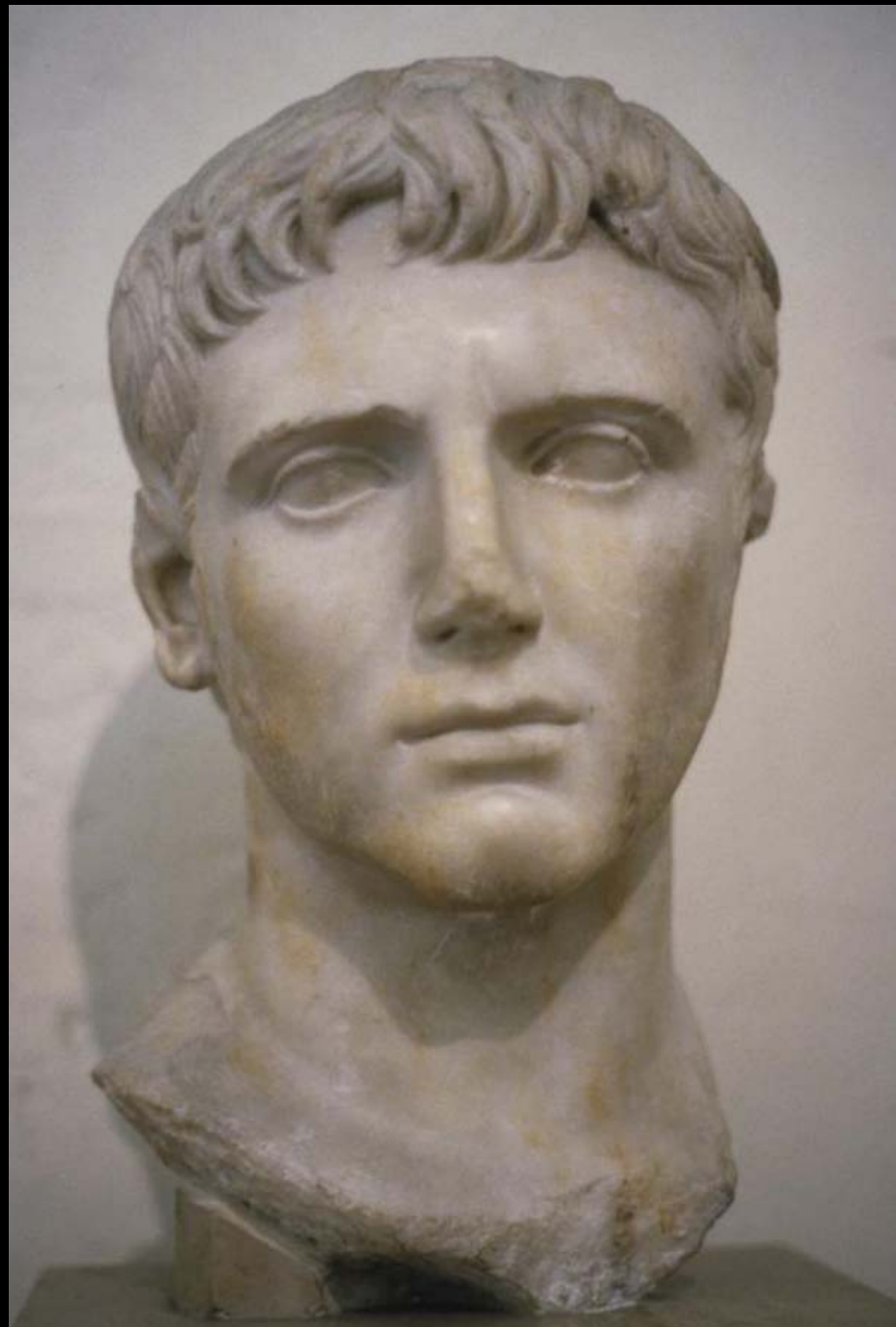
ARLES THEATER (27-5 BC)

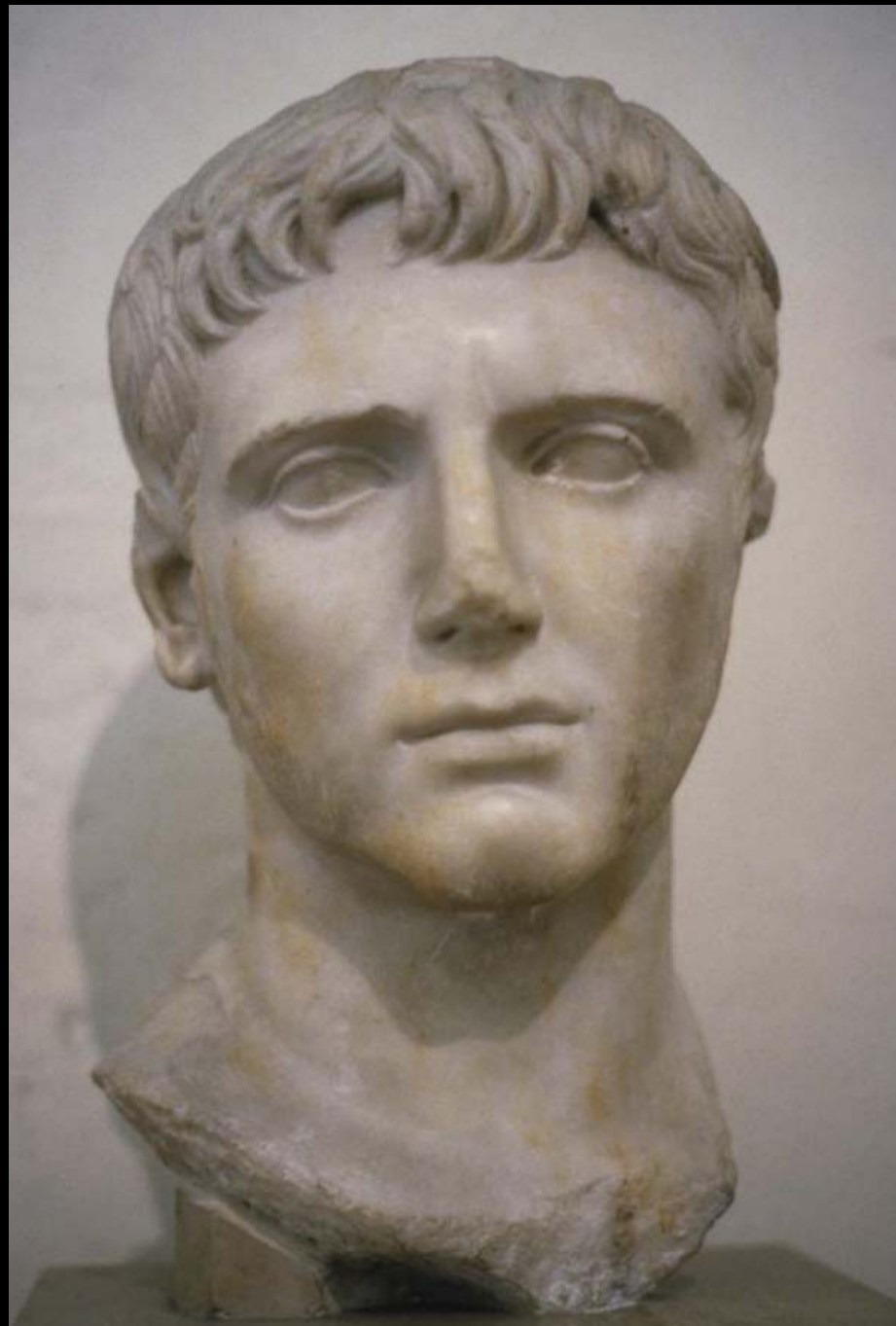


AUGUSTUS STATUE, ARLES THEATER
(12-10 BC)

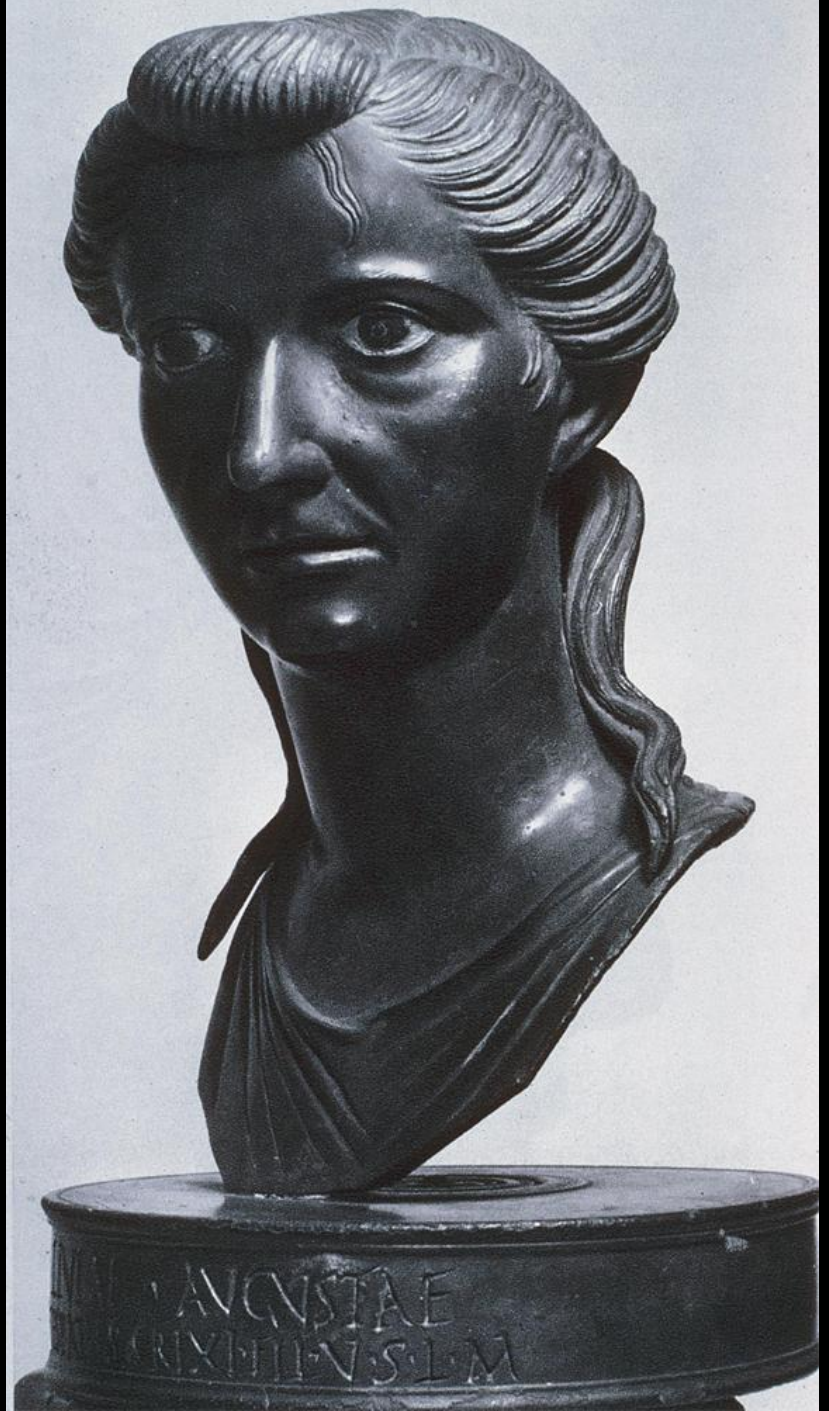








BUSTS OF LIVIA & AUGUSTUS
