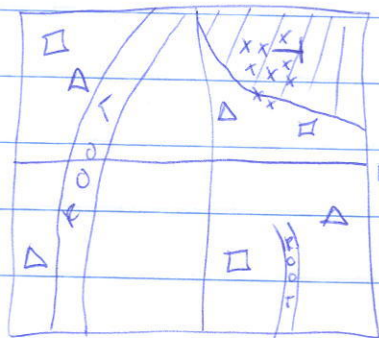

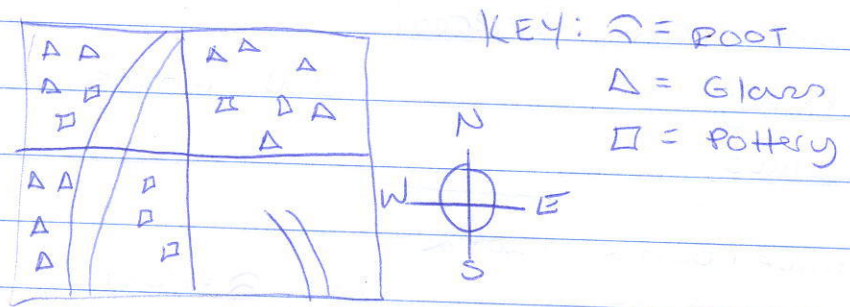

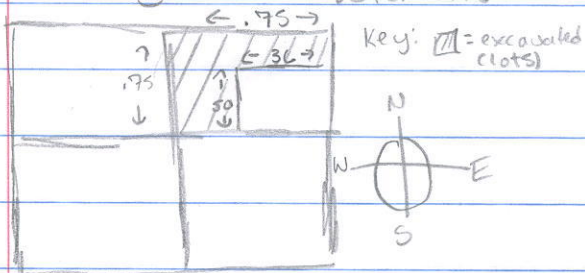

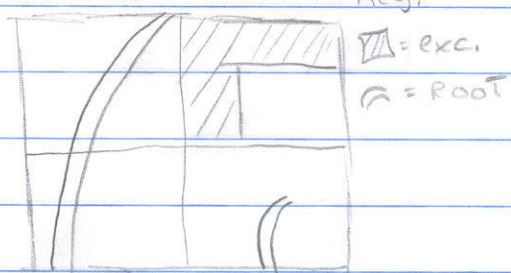
Soil is very orange + sandy, very rocky w/ some roots

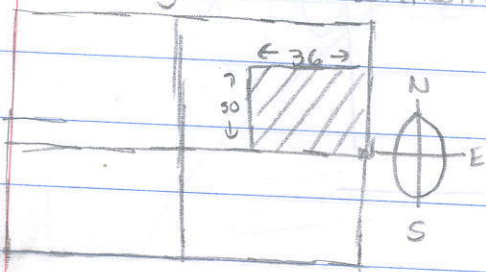


LOT 6: exc. to 55cm by Asa Berkley + Kirin Peaglar

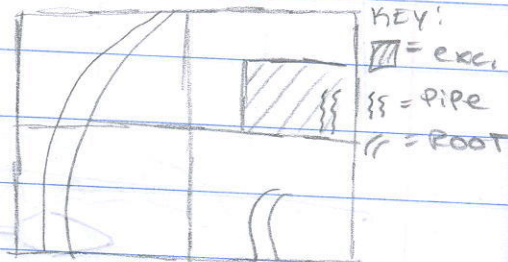

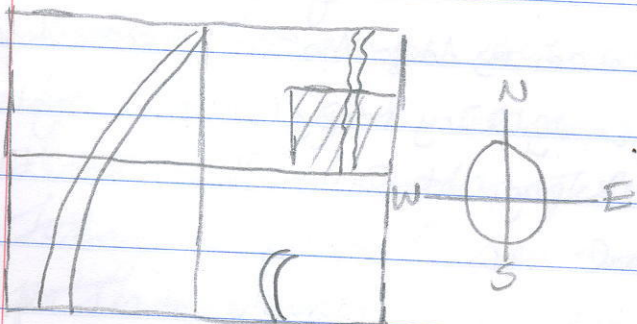


LOT 7: exc. to 55cm

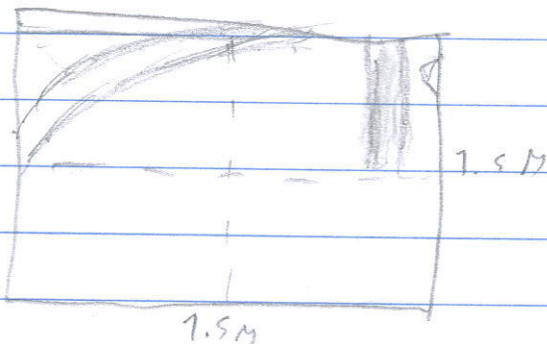
