The Battle of Kadesh


The Hittites on the battle of Kadesh:






Hittite Peace Treaty at Karnak and from the Hittite capital, Hattusha









Merenptah, successor to Rameses II




Private Ramesside monuments:

Medinet Habu: mortuary temple of Rameses III on the west bank at Thebes


