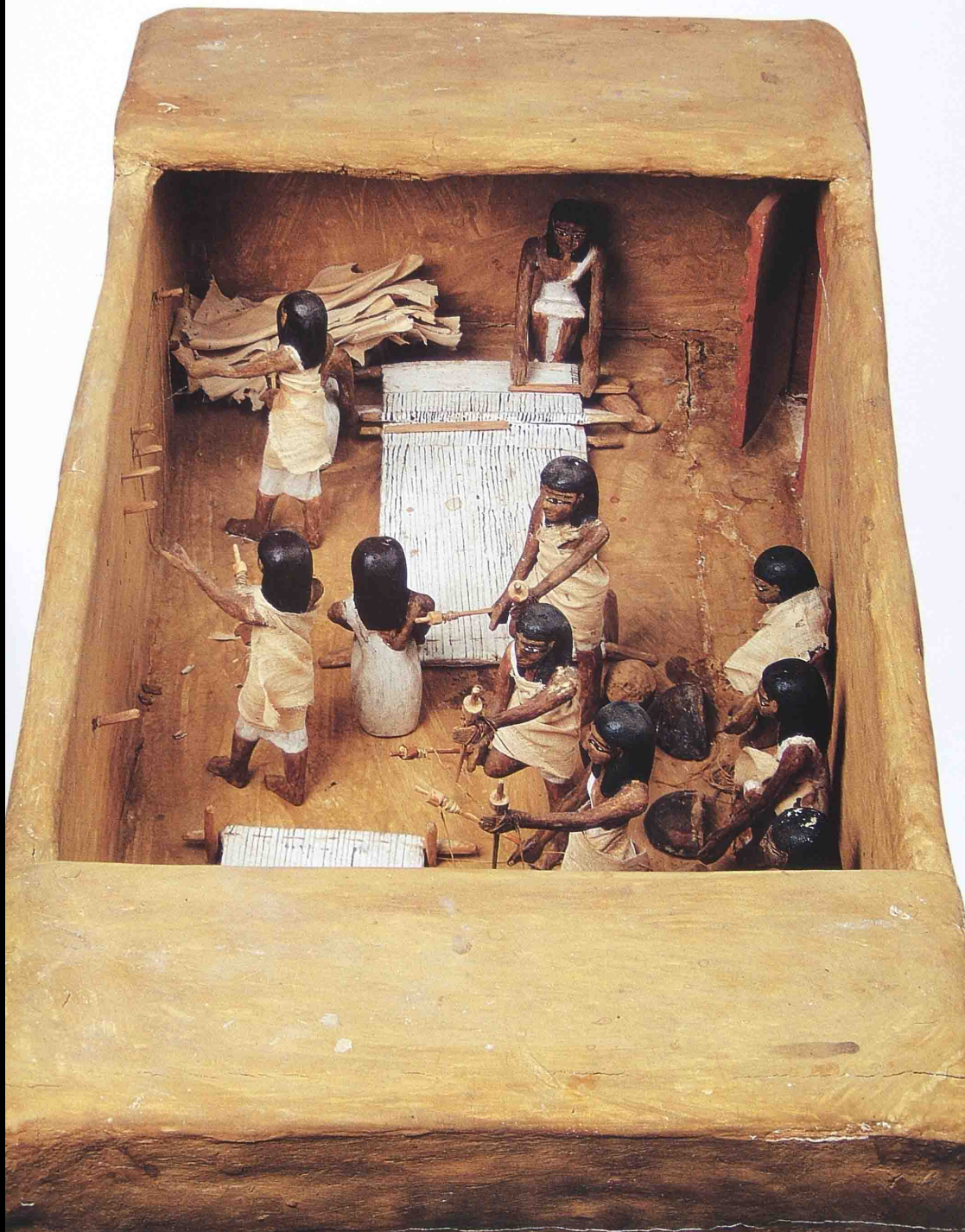

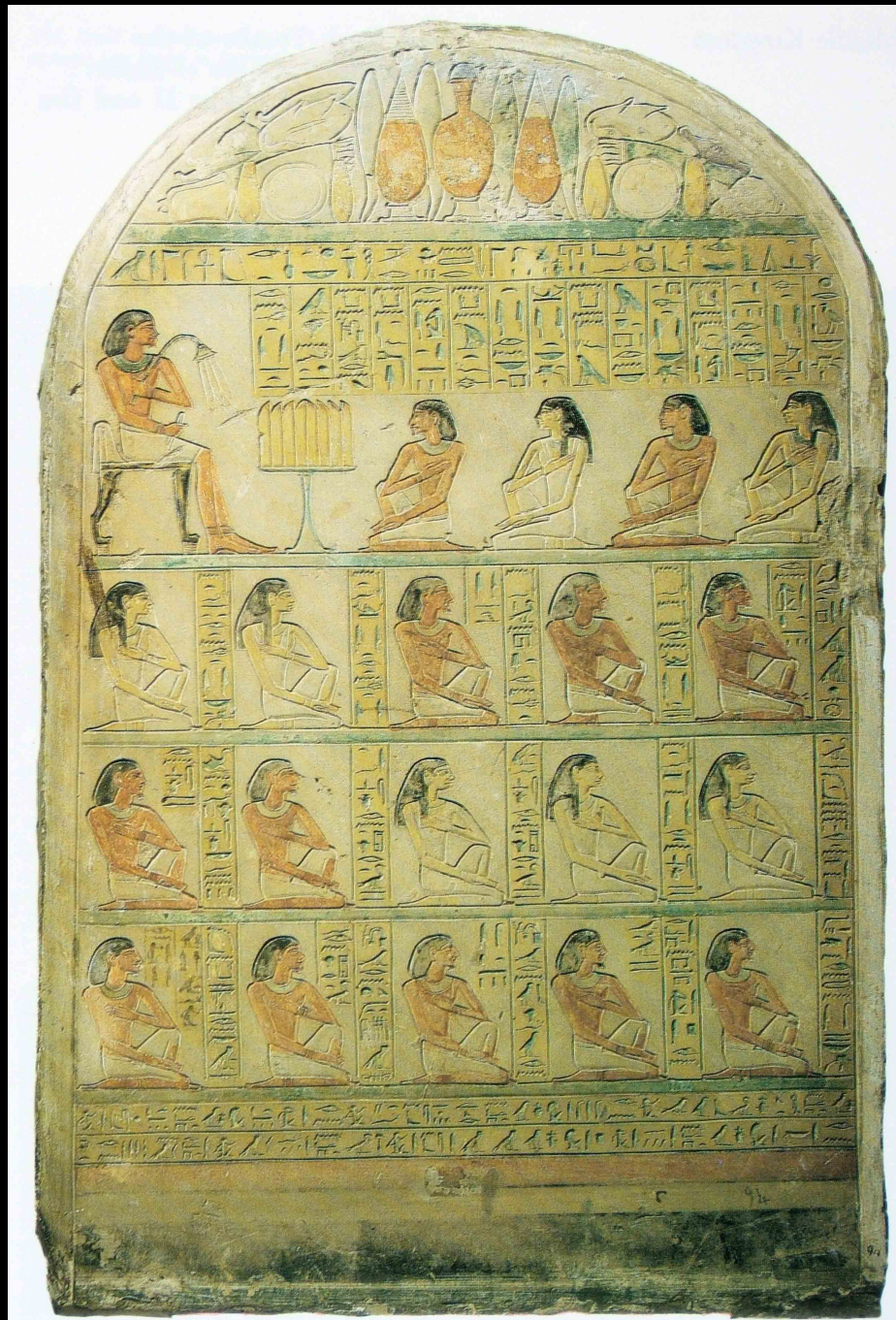

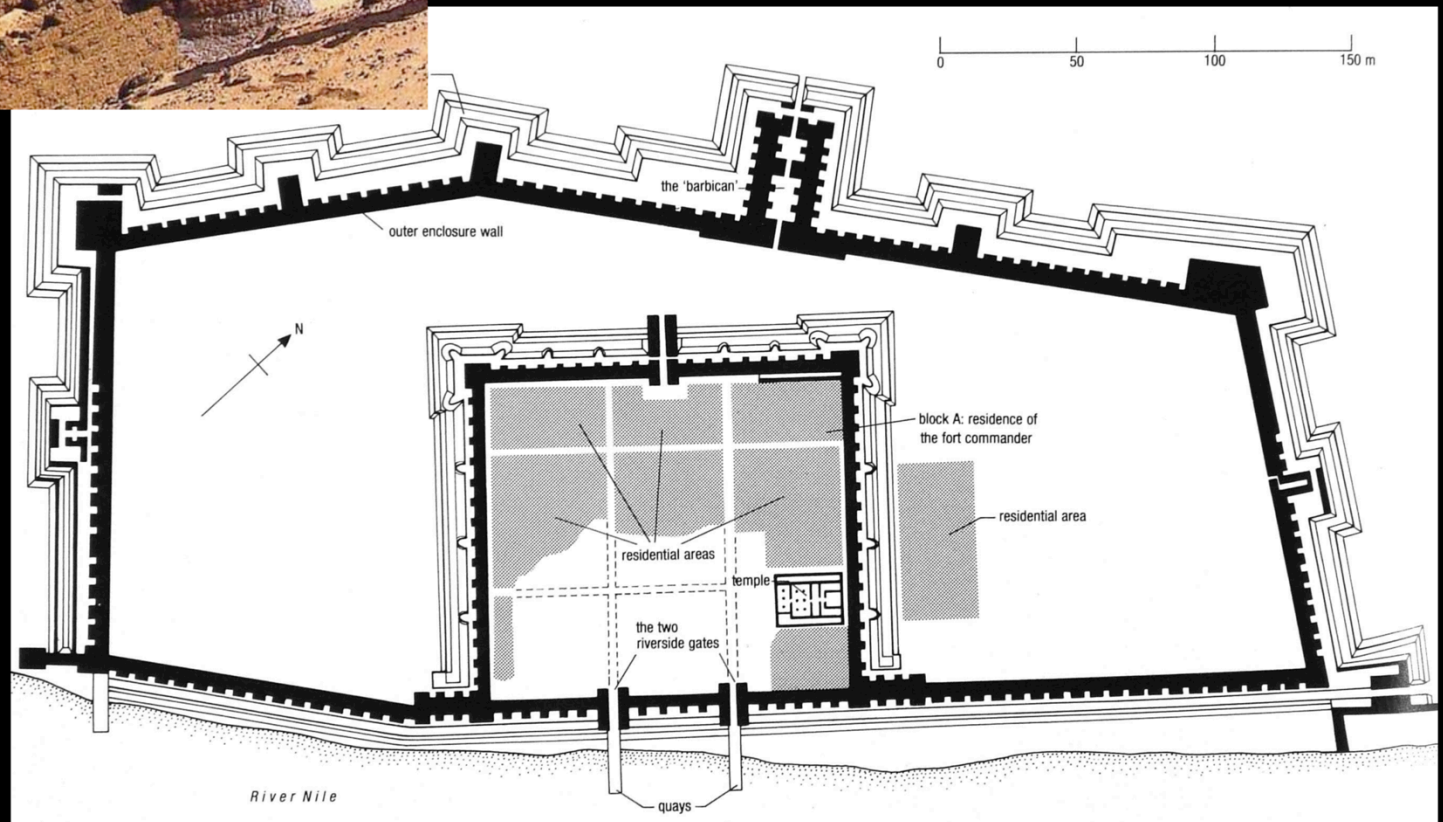

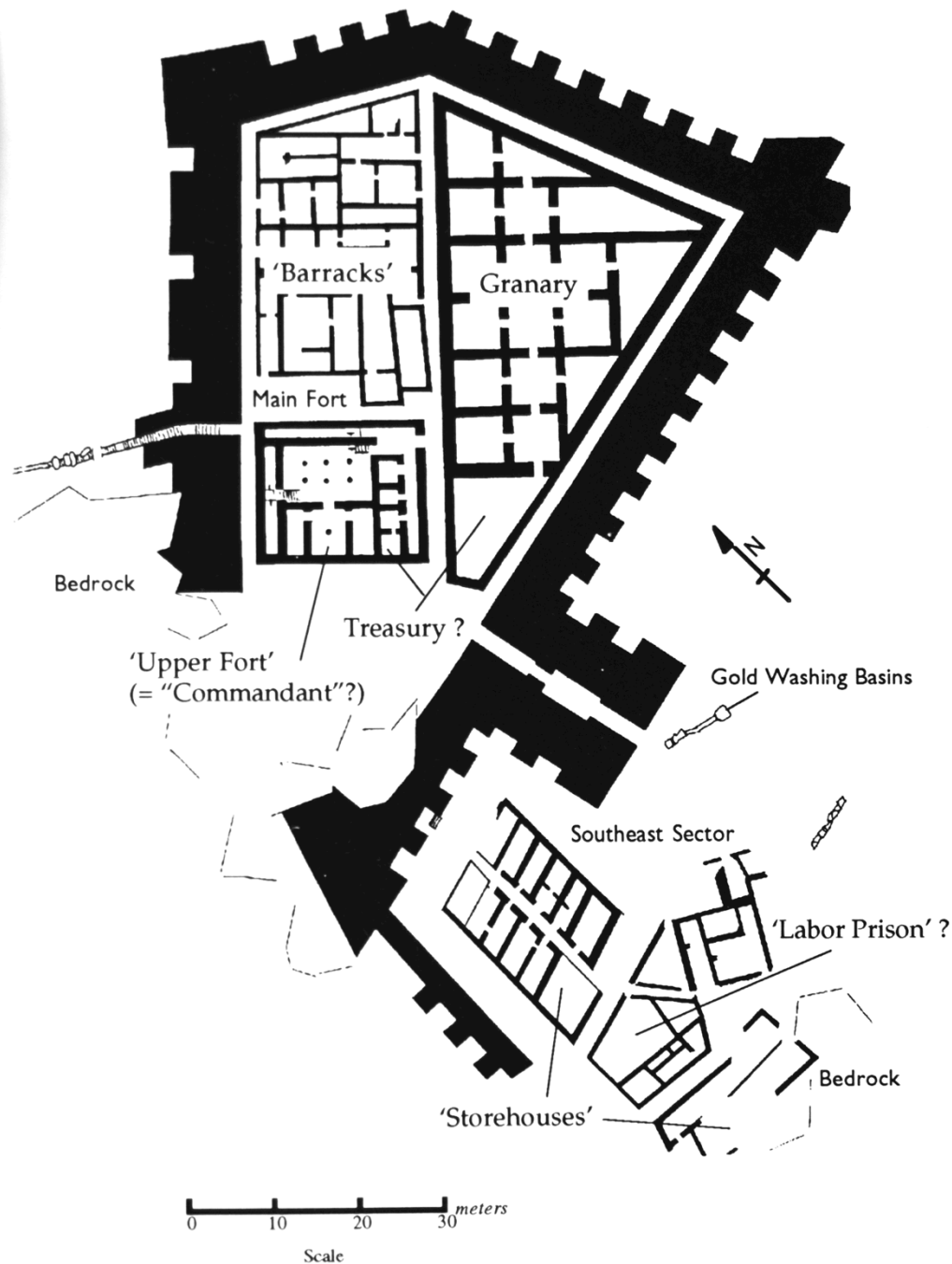
Early Dynasty XII (c. 1985-1773 BC)





Middle Kingdom Fortress at Buhen



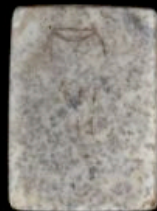

Uronarti fortress

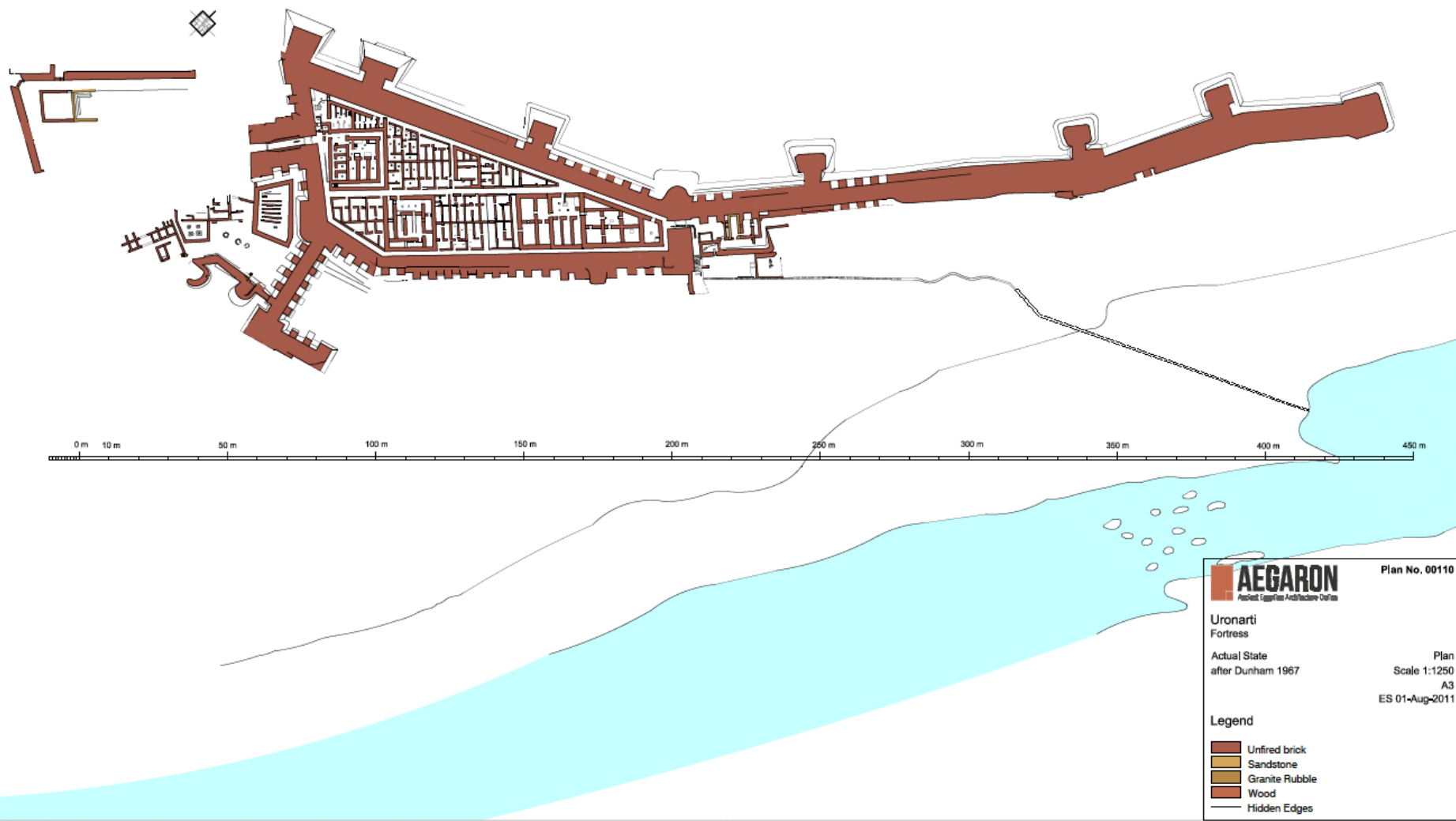


Wooden hieratic tag, stone weight set, and wooden ration token from Uronarti



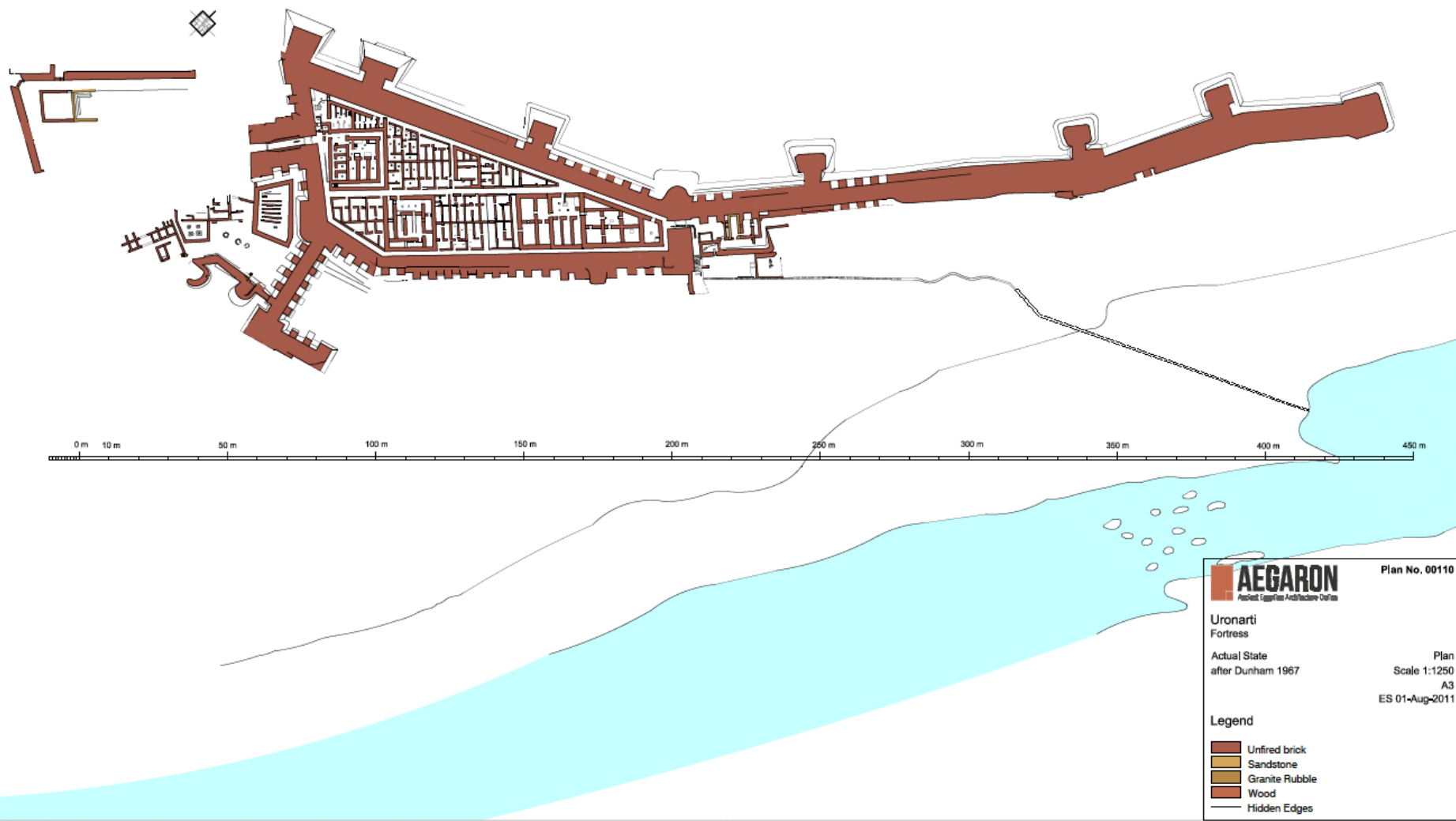
