






Route Maps of 10<sup>th</sup> century Geographers (note the connections of Syrian cities with the frontier and beyond)







Pella (Fihl) Area XXIX The 'Abbasid Complex






'Abbasid Reconstruction of the Amman Citadel after the 749 CE earthquake

#### Glazed 'Abbasid Period Ceramics - Tiberias








### An Assessment of Abbasid Syria


- Syria was not marginalized and managed to maintain sustained economic vitality
- The state did take an interest in the region's economic situation
- Relationship to the Abbasid center, however, was not that of an exploited periphery
- Economically, the region did not generally operate as a province within a larger imperial whole. Local concerns were primary.
- Territorial logics of empire did not dominate economic and social life of Bilad al-Sham


