

Bartholomew Ryan is a postdoctoral fellow at the Institute for the Philosophy of Language (IFILNOVA) at the New University of Lisbon. He holds degrees from Aarhus Universitet, Denmark (PhD, 2006), University College, Dublin (MA, 2002), and Trinity College, Dublin (BA, 1999). He was visiting lecturer at the European College of Liberal Arts in Berlin (2007-2011) and Lady Margaret Hall, University of Oxford (2010), and was a guest scholar at the Søren Kierkegaard Research Centre in Copenhagen (2007 and 2005) and Hong Kierkegaard Library at St. Olaf College, Minnesota (2005). He has written extensively on Kierkegaard, and published articles on Nietzsche, Pessoa, Joyce, Shakespeare and Schmitt. His book *Kierkegaard's Indirect Politics: Interludes with Lukács, Schmitt, Benjamin and Adorno* will be published with Rodopi at the beginning of 2014.
