

T32 Fellow – Faculty Appointment Policy

Recently there has been an increase in the number of departments who wish to appoint T32 Fellows or individuals in fellowship training to faculty positions at Brown. Because these trainees are still in “training,” Brown does not allow for this to occur except for the following circumstance:

The Fellow is applying for career grants and needs to have a faculty appointment if a faculty appointment is stipulated by the funding agency. In this instance, the fellow may be appointed as a Clinical Instructor for a one-year term for purposes of the funding request. If funding is awarded, they may continue with the Clinical Instructor faculty position. If they do not receive funding, their faculty position is rescinded and they return to the Research Fellow or Teaching Fellow status.

It is expected that the dept. submit the granting agency requirement with the request for the faculty appointment.

This applies to trainees in both ACGME and non-ACGME programs.
