RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS

Mellon Mays Undergraduate Fellowship

For rising juniors interested in pursuing social sciences or humanities research and academic careers

Deadline: March 5, 2018

Royce Undergraduate Fellowship

For undergraduates in any discipline interested in pursuing community-engaged research during summer

Deadline: March 16, 2018

OTHER RESEARCH OPPORTUNITIES

Undergraduate Teaching and Research Awards (UTRA)

For undergraduates collaborating with Brown faculty on research and teaching projects during summer or academic year.

Deadlines: May 1st for Fall semester | Nov. 15th for Spring semester | Feb. 10th for Summer

Leadership Alliance

Paid summer research experience that provides training and mentoring for undergraduates interested in applying to PhD or MD-PhD programs. *Must be a U.S. citizen or have permanent resident status at time of application.

Deadline: February 1, 2018

INTERNSHIP FUNDING

LINK/SEW Award

Provides stipend for undergraduates pursuing unpaid or low-paying summer internships in U.S. and abroad.

Deadlines: March 9, 2018 at 12pm | April 11, 2018 at 12pm

iProv in Providence

Provides \$3,500 stipend for undergraduates to work with nonprofit organizations based in greater Providence area

Deadline: March 9, 2018

WHAT ARE FELLOWSHIPS?

Fellowships are 1) opportunities where a group of people engage in research or academic work as peers; and 2) opportunities similar to scholarships that are awarded to individuals on basis of the merit and/or financial need.

WHAT ARE INTERNSHIPS?

Internships are paid and unpaid work opportunities where you are trained in the workings of a company, nonprofit, or other organization.

WHAT IS RESEARCH?

Research can look a variety of different ways depending on the discipline but generally refers to a systematic investigation into a particular topic to answer a specific question.

Note: All opportunities on this sheet are open to undocumented/DACA students, except where noted.

GRADUATE SCHOOL

Institute for Recruitment of Teachers (IRT)

Mentoring program for juniors, seniors, and recent graduates interested in graduate school in humanities, social sciences and education.

Deadline: March 1, 2018

Paul & Daisy Soros Fellowship

Scholarship for immigrants and children of immigrants for graduate school in U.S.

Deadline: November 1, 2018

Baker and Emery Fellowship

\$10,000 scholarship for seniors planning to attend professional or graduate school the year following graduation

Deadline: March 12, 2018
