#### Consortium for Advanced Studies Abroad (CASA) Program in Spain/Barcelona

#### At A Glance

**Program Dates:** Fall semester (late August-late December) or spring semester (early January-late June) or full academic year (late August-late June)

**Language of Instruction:** Spanish and/or Catalan

**Housing:** Single rooms in university residence halls with local and international students

**Eligibility:** Open to Brown undergraduate students and students from other CASA member schools. Applications are encouraged and open to visiting students outside of the CASA consortium.

**Requirements:** Students must be in good academic standing and have completed Advanced Spanish II/HISP 0600 (sixth semester college-level Spanish language), or the equivalent. Visiting students also must have completed at least one upper-level content course in Spanish (typically a third-year course in literature, history or culture) beyond the elementary and intermediate language sequences.
