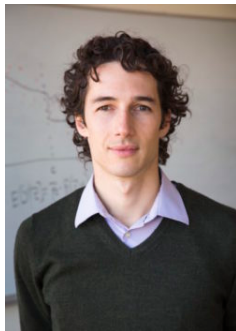
KEYNOTE SPEAKER
