Dr. Bauermeister's work has been funded by the National Institutes of Health, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, as well as supported by the MAC AIDS Fund, the Ford Foundation, and the Herb Ritts Foundation. He works to develop and test sexual health promotion programs that are relevant to vulnerable adolescents and young adults.
