Liberation, Not Integration: Immigrant Activists Making Claims and Making Home in Los Angeles

This talk will explore how DACA recipients and their families have experienced, interpreted, and applied lessons from collective mobilizations, such as a savvy national social media campaign, highly publicized civil disobedience acts, and a sustained barrage of well-articulated demands. While international migration scholars often focus on educational and occupational integration, Professor Abrego argues that political claims-making, too, is a form of immigrant integration not often captured in mainstream discussions of immigrant assimilation.
