

## BROWN STUDENT ACTIVITIES' RIDER

This rider shall be considered an integral part of the lecture agreement dated \_\_\_\_\_ between "\_\_\_\_\_" a recognized student organization at Brown University (hereinafter called "Sponsor") and \_\_\_\_\_ (hereinafter called "Speaker") for the lecture of services as outlined on the accompanying Speaker Agreement. The parties agree as follows:

1. Contractor and his/her agents agree to indemnify and hold harmless Sponsor and Brown University from any claim, damage, liability, injury, expense, or loss arising out of Speaker's lecture of services under this Contract which is not directly caused by the gross negligence of Sponsor or its agents.
2. Sponsor shall have 100% control over publicity, advertising, and promotion of service. Sponsor agrees that all publicity and/or promotion that mentions or makes reference to the Speaker must be approved in writing by Speaker or designee in advance.
3. Sponsor requests one photographer permitted from each the *Liber Brunensis* (campus yearbook) and the *Brown Daily Herald* (campus newspaper) for media coverage solely in campus publications.
4. Sponsor requests permission to simulcast the Speaker's lecture to a nearby venue on Brown's campus if the Sponsor deems that this would be an interest to the Brown Community.
5. While the Speaker has the right to record Speaker's lecture, public use or distribution of such recording requires written permission of Sponsor, if Speaker intends to record.
6. Brown University Department of Public Safety has sole discretion in determining security measures and requirements.
7. Speaker and his/her agents shall observe and abide by all applicable federal and state laws and regulations, including, but not limited to, those of Brown University relative to conduct on its premises.
8. Speaker acknowledges and understands that although Brown University encourages and supports the free exchange of ideas and political viewpoints, as a non-profit, private institution of higher education whose activities are regulated in part by Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, the University is prohibited from engaging in partisan political activity or permitting its resources to be used for support of such activities.
9. No alcohol or illegal drugs will be used by Speaker or his/her agents at any time while on the Brown University campus in connection with this agreement.
10. In performing services and accepting payment under the accompanying lecture agreement, Speaker is deemed an Independent Contractor and shall not act as nor be considered an agent of the Sponsor or Brown University. As such, there will be no employee benefits provided. There will be no withholding of any state or federal taxes or assessment; however, based on the services provided, Brown University shall, on behalf of Sponsor, issue an IRS Form 1099 in Speaker's name.
11. This rider, the accompanying lecture agreement, and any and all attached riders or addendums are not valid without three signatures: one for Speaker, one for Sponsor, and one for the Brown University Student Activities Office.
