SECTION 07 21 00: BUILDING INSULATION

## HEALTHY MATERIALS STANDARDS

Brown University has adopted and continues to evolve its healthy materials building standards. This program is intended to eliminate certain materials with known or

suspected negative impacts to human health, particularly vulnerable populations. Brown has built an interactive platform for planning, design and construction teams to identify acceptable (required/baseline) and preferred healthy materials. The University strives to select the preferred versus required (baseline) materials and teams should explore the cost/benefits of both. Any deviation from the acceptable materials will require a waiver to be signed off by The AVP of Sustainability and Resiliency. Please work with your Project Manager to navigate the Hub. - 1. GENERAL
  - A. All interior partitions are to be acoustically insulated with particular attention to offices, dormitory rooms and rooms with special audio / visual requirements or equipment. The following is the minimum sound isolation requirement (Sound Transmission Class (STC) rating) for all paths (walls, ceilings and floors) between the source and the receiver:

- B. All mechanical and utility penetrations and chases shall be acoustically insulated.
- C. Internal duct lining are not allowed; only external duct insulation is to be used; lining will be reviewed and approved by the Brown Project Manager.
