SECTION 32 92 00: TURFS & GRASSES

1. GENERAL

A. Lawns are to be treated as featured central carpets. The extent of lawn is to be reduced where possible, with open space edges planted with groundcovers. Prominent open green spaces to be planted with sod, not seeded.

B. Lawn Seed:

- 1. 30% Kentucky bluegrass, 50% Creeping Red Fescue, 20% perennial Ryegrass
- 2. Seed mixture: fresh, clean, new crop seed, and in no case, should the weed seed content exceed 1% by weight.

C. Grass Sod:

- 1. Provide strongly rooted, mature, vigorous, healthy, commercially grown grass sod not less than 2 years old and free of weeds, insects, diseases, stone, other grasses, and other deleterious matter.
- 2. Predominantly bluegrass containing an admixture of chewings and/or red fescue grasses for shady locations.
- 3. Kentucky bluegrass to contain two and preferably three of the following improved strains such as Fylking, Baron, Warren A-20, Warren A-34, or Pennlawn.

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
