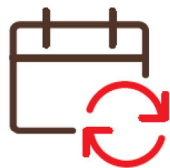
Brown University's dedication to preserving and honoring the past guides Brown's vision for the built environment, and has established the University as a national leader in historic preservation.

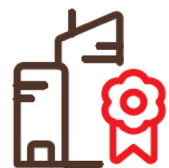
