

Project Bluetooth Connect

Researchers at Brown University are developing Bluetooth beacon-based technology to understand alcohol use and other health behaviors among friends.

Participation in this confidential research study involves completing surveys on a smartphone several times a day over 21 days, completing two in-person visits at Brown University and identifying three friends who we will ask to participate in a part of the study (with assistance from researchers).

You may be eligible to participate if you:

- Are 18-29 years old
- Own an Android phone
- Speak English
- Drink alcohol with friends regularly

Eligible participants can earn up to \$255 for taking part in the study.
