

# The PRO Study

Physiological Responses and Observations for young adults

## What is the PRO Study?

The goal of this project is to learn more about how the minds and bodies of adults with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) react to their social environment. By better understanding these reactions, we can improve our abilities to diagnosis ASD and we can develop better therapies for those with ASD. To accomplish this goal, this project is exploring potential differences in body responses during different experiences. Participants will have their physiology (heart and nervous system responses) recorded non-invasively during a lab visit and some participants may be given equipment to take home and wear overnight.

## Who can participate?

We are looking for 18-25 year old adults with autism or typically developing adults.

## What is involved?

Participants will attend a visit at the Brown Center for Children:

- Lab Visit: Physiology tasks (1-2 hours)
