I would also discuss what causes training of neural network compute extensive. In brief, I would like to convince the audience that deep learning is not computationally expensive by accident, but by design. This paper presents a reasonable compute performance model for deep learning, which is very simple and establishes a computational complexity for a generic NN model.
