

This document describes how to clear your browser cache in the even that InfoEd is not working properly. If you clear your cache and still have issues, contact IACUC@brown.edu.

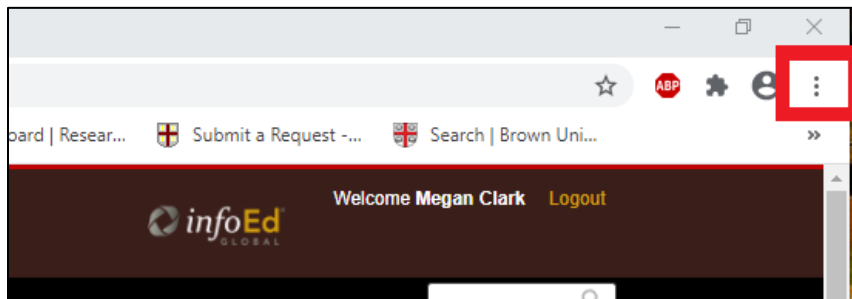
****PLEASE NOTE**** Google Chrome is the only approved browser for use with InfoEd.

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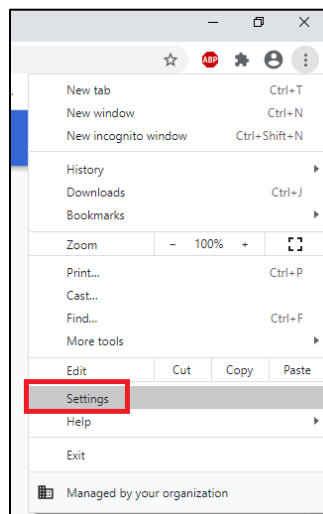
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Clear the Google Chrome Cache

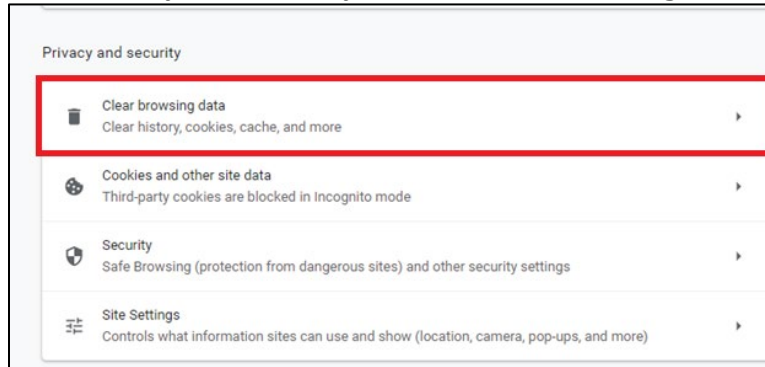
1. Click on the three dots in the top right corner of the Chrome browser:



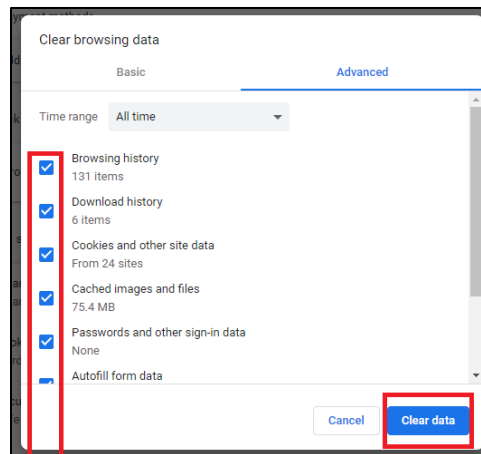
2. Click "Settings"



3. Scroll down to “Privacy and Security”. Click “Clear browsing data”



4. In the window that pops up, make sure all the boxes on the left are checked off. You might have to scroll a little to see all the boxes. Then click “Clear Data.”

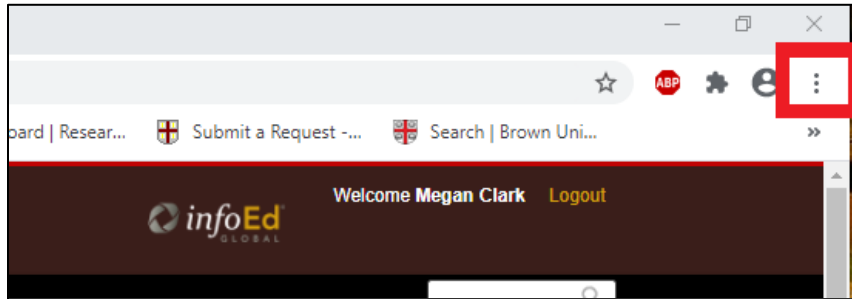


5. Done!

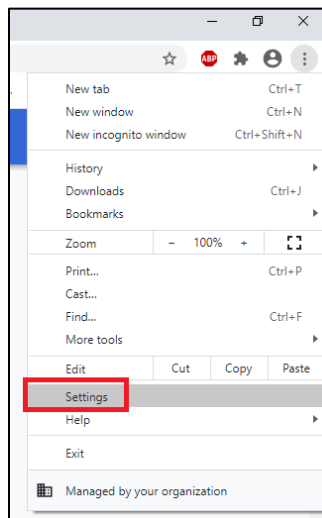
Set Up Auto Clear Every Time you Close InfoEd or Chrome

It can be handy to set up Chrome to auto-clear your InfoEd cache every time you leave InfoEd or your browser. Follow these steps to automate the cache clearing procedure!

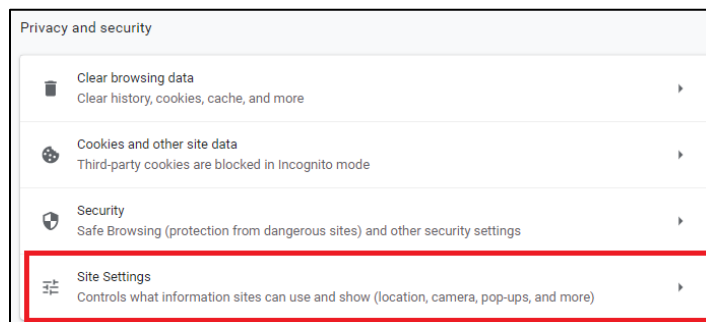
1. Click on the three dots in the top right corner of the Chrome browser:



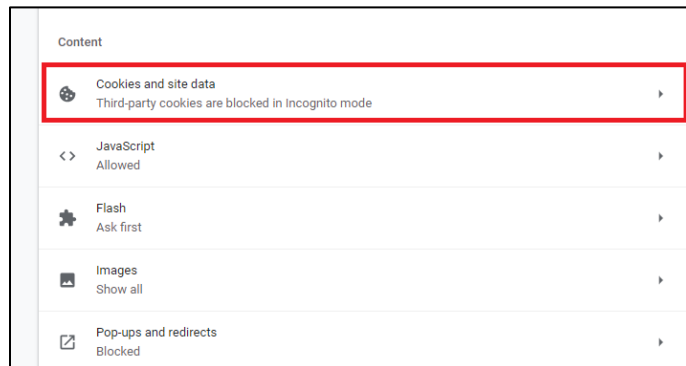
2. Click "Settings"



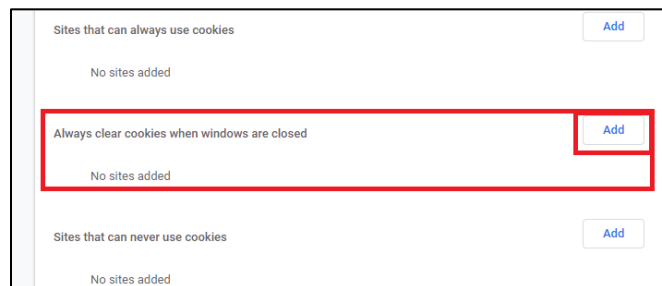
3. Scroll down to "Privacy and Security". Click on "Site Settings"



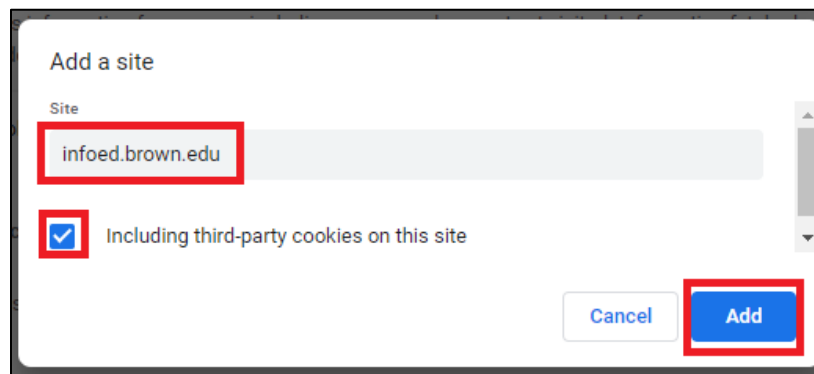
4. Scroll down to the "Content" section and click on "Cookies and Site Data"



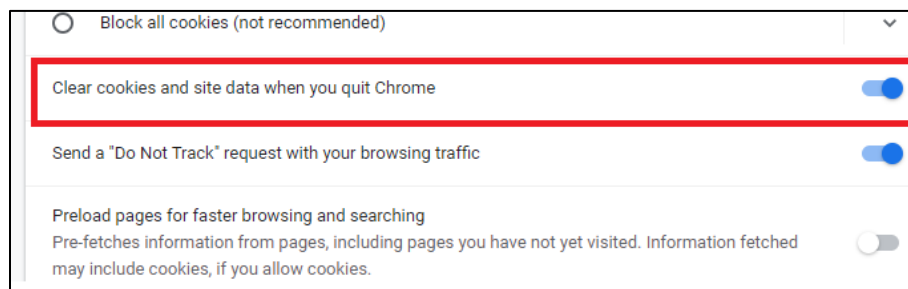
5. Scroll down to “Always clear cookies when windows are closed.” Click “Add”



6. Type “infoed.brown.edu” (remember- NO www here). Check off the third party cookies box. Then click “Add.”



7. If you want to add an extra step of protection, scroll up on the settings page and make sure the toggle switch is set to “On” for “Clear cookies and site data when you quit Chrome”



8. Done!
