➤ **ABOUT THE NIH – ADDITIONAL INVESTIGATOR(S) QUESTIONNAIRE:**

The purpose of this questionnaire is to identify any individuals, other than the PI or Contact PI, who meet the NIH definition of investigator: An “Investigator” means the principal investigator or the project director and any other person, regardless of title or position, who is responsible for the design, conduct, or reporting of research funded by the NIH, or proposed for such funding.

The questionnaire must be completed for all proposals that are submitted to NIH and subcontracts with an NIH Prime.

➤ ABOUT THE NSF – ADDITIONAL INVESTIGATOR(S) QUESTIONNAIRE

The purpose of this questionnaire is to identify any individuals, other than the PI, who meet the NSF definition of investigator: An “Investigator” means the principal investigator or the project director and any other person responsible for the design, conduct, or reporting of research.

For the purpose of reporting a significant financial interest, “Investigator” includes the Investigator’s spouse and/or dependent children.

The questionnaire must be completed for all proposals that are submitted to NSF and subcontracts with an NSF Prime.
